MARIE VAN BUREN TO BE GUEST SPEAKER

Marie Van Buren, A Historical Preservation Consultant of Atlanta will be the guest speaker at the Tuesday, January 28 meeting of the Washington County Historical Society. She will present a slide talk on log cabins and other early structures typical of Middle Georgia.

The meeting will be on Tuesday, January 28 at 7:30 P.M. at the Sandersville Fire Department Conference room. This is one night later than the regular meeting. Ms. Van Buren teaches a Monday night course at Emory University in Atlanta on local architecture.

In addition to presenting a slide lecture on log cabins and other very early structures, Ms. Van Buren will consult in several ways on projects of the Historical Society. She will meet with a joint committee of the Historical Society and Elderites to design and seek funding for a comprehensive heritage education program working out of the Elder Community Center.

On Wednesday, January 29, she will present her talk at Brentwood School to Mary Moye's history students who have researched "Finding My Place in Washington County." At Elder Middle School she will talk to Jean Brown's Georgia History students and Lisa Franklin's eighth grade Discovery Class.

Ms. Van Buren will also consult with the Historic Sites and Districts Committee on their projected Driving Tours for visitors and tourist to linger and learn in our community.
